### 1. How will the workshop be conducted?

### 2. Will there be a cost for the workshop?

The workshop is sponsored by CMS Canada and the Winnipeg Church of Christ, so there is no cost for participants to attend the workshop. ***There is a 145 page workbook which can be downloaded from our website.***

### 3. Will the workshop be recorded?

The workshop will not be recorded for privacy reasons. (Nor is any recording allowed.)

#### **4. What does each session consist of?**

Each session will consist of fellowship; a video broadcast from the Winnipeg, Canada; small group discussion in breakout rooms; and some sessions will have couples sharing from their own lives. **For those participants with a lower bandwidth that cannot view the video properly, we will provide a link to the video content on a weekly basis.**

#### **5. Intended Audience**

This program is intended for the members of the International Churches of Christ in the Caribbean. It will be taught from a Christian perspective with Jesus being at the center of your marriage.

#### **6. Breakout Rooms (A)**

Sharing in the rooms is encouraged but we must be wise about what we share as we really do not know the other people (even though they are members)

#### **7. Breakout Rooms (B)**

The participants for the breakout room are randomly assigned, as such it would **not** be possible to:

1. Assign you to a specific room
2. We cannot assign a facilitator to each room. Someone should start the discussion.
3. If there is someone who is in the room and does not acknowledge their presence - please message the facilitator (using the chat function) and he will be able to remove that person to a special waiting room. (Open the chat and look for David and let him know the participant and room number)
