1. How will the workshop be conducted?

2. Will there be a cost for the workshop?

3. Will the workshop be recorded?

4. What does each session consist of?

Each session will consist of fellowship; a video broadcast from the Winnipeg, Canada; small group discussion in breakout rooms; and some sessions will have couples sharing from their own lives. For those participants with a lower bandwidth that cannot view the video properly, we will provide a link to the video content on a weekly basis.

5. Intended Audience

This program is intended for the members of the International Churches of Christ in the Caribbean. It will be taught from a Christian perspective with Jesus being at the center of your marriage.

6. Breakout Rooms (A)

Sharing in the rooms is encouraged but we must be wise about what we share as we really do not know the other people (even though they are members)

7. Breakout Rooms (B)
